The project is based in Abeka, in the Democratic Republic of Congo and is supported by Manchester and Warrington area meeting, and Cambridgeshire area meeting.

An earlier QPSW Relief grant meant that clean water was delivered to the hospital and the community in 2016 - basins, toilets and showers were installed in the hospital for the first time.

This current project will provide hospital equipment and training, which will improve health care in the area so that patients will no longer have to make difficult journeys on unmade-up roads to better-equipped hospitals some distance away. If the hospital is able to attract more patients and increase income from fees, local health zone funding should follow.
