Two years ago, Hurricane Matthew hit Vilia's neighbourhood. Thankfully, Vilia's new home was strong enough to stand up to the storm. And not only was her house the safest place in the area, it provided shelter for many of her neighbours. In fact, it sheltered 54 people whilst many of their homes were destroyed.
