This is a 'taster workshop' exploring different aspects of children and young people's work in a Quaker context. It is for people in meetings working with children who wish to develop their skills and approaches or people who are considering working with children in meetings.

The cost of the workshop is £5 payable on the day. All participants should bring a packed lunch.

The aims of the workshop are:

- To encourage participants to consider how they relate to children within children's meeting and share aspects of working in children's meeting that they find challenging.
- To help adults in a Quaker setting to share and explore difficulties, dilemmas and joys of working with groups of children with a wide range of ages.
- To recognise the importance of developing meaningful relationships between young people and adults and look at a range of spiritual exploration activities suitable for use with young people.

By the end of the workshop participants will have:

- Thought about their children's meeting, and how it is structured and how alternative approaches might be helpful to make it a safe and enjoyable experience for all.
- Looked at difficulties, dilemmas and positive possibilities of working with a wide age range of children groups of children.
- Considered theories and ideas about children's wellbeing development and children's spirituality.
- Thought about further workshops they might want to attend.
