

Human Bingo

This is an ice-breaker. Give everyone a sheet with questions. The task is to meet as many people they do not know and find if they can positively answer one of these questions.

Give one person in the group some post-it notes. This symbolises a sexually transmitted disease, but don't tell them that, yet! Whenever they talk to anyone, they give half the post-it notes to that person. The next people do this in turn. So the post-it notes circulate around the group like a sexually transmitted disease.

When someone calls house or the exercise comes to an end ask how many have the post-it notes.

Ask what the post–it notes could symbolise. Explain that it represents how sexually transmitted diseases are spread.
