The Quaker Living Wage Campaign

In June 2015 Lancaster Meeting was invited to lead a Quaker Living Wage Campaign as part of Friends' approach to following up Quaker Equality Week held in March 2015. Since then a pack of materials to support Local Meetings campaign has been developed it is available to download from our website

80 plus Local Meetings have taken packs and some have started campaigning. Throughout the past 21 months we have been supported by the Economic, Sustainability and Peace Team of Quaker Peace and Social Witness.

The Lancaster Group leading the campaign is focusing on encouraging all parts of the Britain Yearly Meeting Quaker community to not only pay the Living Wage but also to gain accreditation as Living Wage Employers. Our own Area Meeting, Central & North Lancashire has gained accreditation as have Manchester & Warrington; York; Pendle Hill; Mid Thames and South East Scotland Area Meetings. Others are moving towards accreditation.

Whilst we welcome the rise in the statutory *national living wage* to £7.50 an hour for those over 25 it falls short of the voluntary **Living Wage** currently calculated at **£8.45** and the **London Living Wage** at **£9.75** an hour. These **Living Wages** are real living wages reflecting the basic cost of living and the availability of working tax credits. The rates are independently recalculated each year for November by The Living Wage Foundation: www.livingwage.org.uk

Our message is simple: A LIVING WAGE MUST PAY ENOUGH TO LIVE ON.

The **Swarthmore Lecture** to be delivered by Catherine West MP at **Yearly Meeting Gathering (YMG)** this year will address inequality, tackling poverty and promoting social justice. If we are to live out our faith we must get our own house in order. The Quaker Living Wage Campaign Group will run a Special Interest Meeting at YMG to support Area Meetings and others who wish to seek accreditation as Living Wage Employers thus enabling them to witness that they a fair and just wage to their employees.
