ABOUT SWARTHMOOR HALL

Swarthmoor Hall, is a 16th Century country house which has special significance for Quakers. It is known as the cradle of Quakerism because Judge Thomas Fell and his wife Margaret providing protection and hospitality for early Friends, notably George Fox and allowed the Hall to be a headquarters for the movement. Today, that tradition of hospitality remains. We can accommodate up to 25 people, with some people sharing in twin rooms. Our catering is vegetarian and we provide tea and cake on arrival and each afternoon in our Friendship Room.

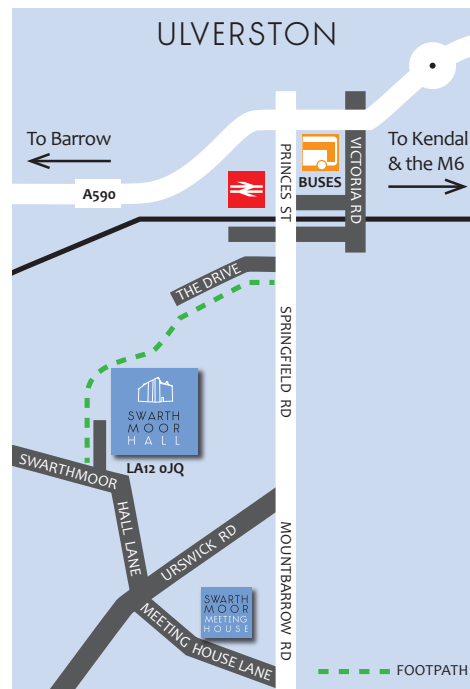

HOW TO FIND US

Swarthmoor Hall is set in rolling countryside close to fells, lakes and the coast, and just outside the small lively market town of Ulverston, in the Lake District.



By rail

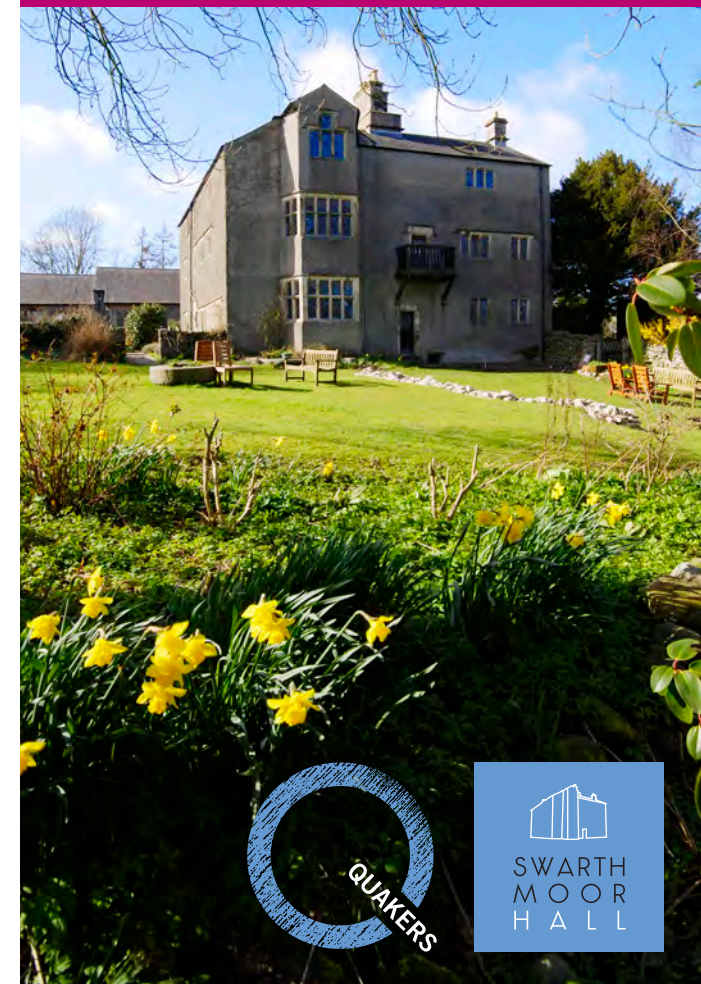
Ulverston is 45 minutes from Lancaster station, which is about 2 hours from London Euston. Ulverston railway station is a 15 minute walk from the Hall. Taxis can be booked in advance. Please contact the Hall if you would like details of local taxi firms.

By road

Swarthmoor Hall, Ulverston is just a 25 minute drive from junction 36 of the M6 motorway. Postcode is LA12 0JQ.

By bus

Stagecoach Cumberland service X35 runs regularly from Kendal to Ulverston.

Swarthmoor Hall is known for its beautiful surroundings and also for its hospitality. What better place to relax and unwind? Or for those who are looking for a more active break the Hall provides the perfect base for an activity holiday. It is within a few minutes of the Lake District National Park and all that it has to offer: quaint villages, spectacular scenery of lakes & mountains and places to visit. We offer our accommodation on a self-catering or bed & breakfast basis. Full board can be arranged for larger groups. We are open throughout the year.



SELF CATERING

We have five suites of rooms in the beautiful, peaceful and historic setting of Swarthmoor Hall. Our guests are very welcome to enjoy our beautiful gardens and grounds. You can sit and relax, picnic - we even have our own campfire site The gardens and wildflower meadow, which becomes a carpet of purple crocuses in the spring.

Suite 1

This is a spacious ground floor suite of rooms which was designed for people with limited mobility. It has two twin bedrooms and an open plan living space with fitted kitchen, dining table and living area with TV. A sofa bed in the living room means that suite 1 can accommodate up to six people. It looks out to the front of the old Hall, its gardens and farmland & woodland beyond.

Suite 2

Suite 2 is situated in the old Hall. On the ground floor it has a single and a twin bedroom with a shower room. On the same floor there is also a kitchen and sitting room with an open fire. On the second floor there are two further twin bedrooms – one has an en-suite bathroom and the other a bathroom next door. All of the twin bedrooms in this suite have wonderful views over the Hall's gardens and beyond to the Fells.

Suite 3

Suite 3 is also situated in the old Hall. The accommodation is arranged over two floors. On the first floor it has a twin bedroom with wash hand basin and a bathroom close by. On the same floor it also has a lovely bright living space with fitted kitchen, dining table, sofa bed, armchairs and TV. Through original mullioned windows the view looks out toward the archway which marks the entrance to the Hall and farmland beyond.

Suite 4

This suite is in a link detached house with wonderful views across our gardens and grounds and to the Hills beyond from the main bedroom, sitting room and its separate kitchen/ dining room. From this room doors open to a small patio overlooking the garden. It has three upstairs bedrooms – a double, a twin and a single bedroom, plus a family bathroom. On the ground floor there is a spacious sitting room with sofa bed and armchairs. There is also a kitchen and dining room, and a downstairs cloakroom.

Suite 5

Suite 5 is the smallest of our units. It is on the ground floor in a recently converted outbuilding, and comprises a twin bed-sitting room with a spacious en-suite shower room and access to full kitchen facilities
