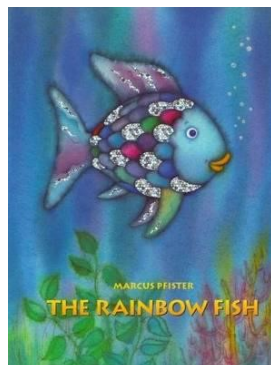

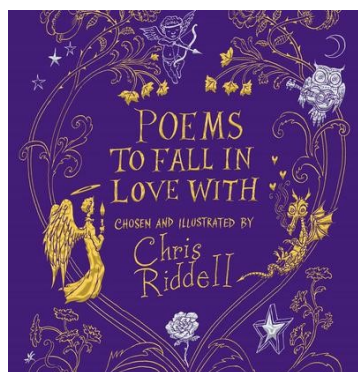


### **THE RAINBOW FISH** **Marcus Pfister £6.99**

Eye-catching foil stamping, glittering on every page, it offers instant child-appeal, but it is the universal message at the heart of this simple story about a beautiful fish who learns to make friends by sharing his most prized possessions, that gives the book its lasting value.

The third book in the wickedly funny series for ages six and up from the creator of *Where Bear?*, *Pass It On* and the *Pom Pom* series, has colour illustrations throughout. Hi! 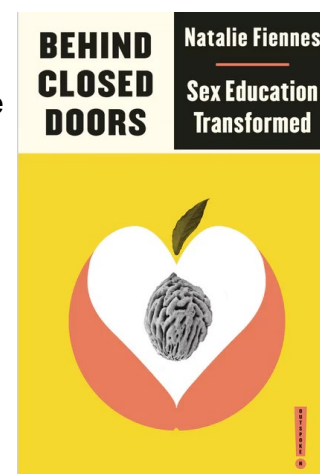


### **POEMS TO FALL IN LOVE WITH** **Chris Riddell £12.99**

### **BEHIND CLOSED DOORS: Sex Education Transformed** **Natalie Fiennes £9.99**

One thing we know for certain is that sex is personal: perhaps the most intimate thing of all, but sex is also shaped by a complicated web of cultural, social and political forces outside of ourselves. Fear-mongering, moral panic and outdated attitudes prevail, but if #MeToo has taught us anything, it's how dangerous it is to keep conversations about sex hidden from view. *Behind Closed Doors* invests in a radical, inclusive and honest sex education, taking us beyond learning about the 'birds and the bees' to identifying inequality that stands in the way of sexual freedom. From contraceptives to virginity, consent to pornography, transphobia to sexual abuse, the book shows how our desires are influenced by powerful political processes that can be transformed.





## MASK OFF: Masculinity Redefined

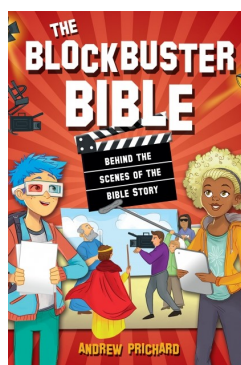
### JJ Bola £9.99

What is masculinity? Dominating the world around us, from Trump's twitter outbursts to deadly gun violence, masculinity is perceived to be 'toxic', 'fragile' and 'in crisis'. JJ Bola exposes masculinity as a performance that men are socially conditioned into. Using examples of non-Western cultural traditions, music and sport, he shines light on historical narratives around manhood and debunking popular myths along the way. He explores how LGBTQ men, men of colour and male refugees experience masculinity in diverse ways, revealing its fluidity and how it's strengthened and weakened by different political contexts, such as the patriarchy or the far-right, and perceived differently by those around them.
