The project is based in Mbale, Uganda and is supported by Bedford meeting.

The project began in the aftermath of floods and landslides in 2019 and 2022, caring for 150 orphaned children. Many have been found foster families which need continuing support, but 30 are still housed in the project's single building. Thanks to donations of land, money and volunteers' time, the project has been able to construct a new building to house the 30 orphans in its care, but there are few play facilities. The grant will help to fund the teacher's salary and a reconditioned laptop for the school secretary, as well as play equipment for the children.
