Whether you consider it solidarity, compensation or reparations, we know that hundreds of billions a year are needed – and that money must come from those who caused the crisis. But progress on this has been slow.

Quakers in Britain works with faith groups and NGOs as part of the Make Polluters Pay campaign to call for a loss and damage fund paid for by the biggest polluters.

We do this by:

- **joining** the annual Make Polluters Pay Action Day
- **pressing** governments on the need for loss and damage funding
- **supporting** people of faith to join the campaign and take action or raise awareness
- **sharing** information about the campaign.
