## Reduce

Fewer overburdened Friends More time for Spirit led witness and community Less long tiring business meetings Fewer separate area charities duplicating Skype: less travel time and carbon, opens up access

#### Re-use

Good ideas from other meetings Policy documents: stop re-inventing the wheel Tried and tested Quaker methods Buildings you have, and spaces others have

## Recycle

Don't retain things for ever and ever Melt them down Re-form them for new shapes and purposes Keeping the inner Quaker principles

## Repair

Repairing saves energy Spending a little can fix things you value Other people may have the skills you need

## Refuse

Say no to some things. Just stop doing them. With joy. There's always another way.

## Rethink

Take a fresh approach. Include different people. Divide busy roles: match people with tasks they like. Do it differently. Experiment. Believe it possible that you are mistaken!!

#### Rot

For a nutritious compost, lay some things down, Stir, leave in the warm and dark And in the quiet, listen for the Spirit: Something good will grow from it.
