SANCTU

The project is based in Lancaster and is supported by Lancaster Quaker meeting, a Sanctuary Meeting.

Asylum seekers have limited financial resources, living on just over £5 a day, so there are many expenses they find difficult to meet. Since mid-2018 asylum seekers in Lancaster have been required to register at a police station in Liverpool, whereas previously they had been able to do this in Lancaster itself. Because of their extremely limited funds they have been unable to pay the train fares, so the project has been providing them with 'destitution grants'. The QPSW Relief grant will help to provide funding for these.
