- How would you encourage other meetings?

We are hoping each community's contribution will be about a page – less will be fine.

Are there texts or books that you have specifically referred to?

Do you have any quotes from people in your meeting that will help to bring some colour and depth to what you describe? Make sure the person is happy for their words to be used if they can be identified.
