VOH2023

The Voice of Hope project is based in Burundi and is supported by Mid Essex Area Meeting.

The project supports the education of 15 orphaned children. It pays their school fees, provides stationery and other necessary items such as uniforms and bags, as well as providing personal support and supervision for the children during the week

Originally Voice of Hope arose out of a musical group formed by young Congolese Quakers, moved to Burundi and was joined by some young Burundian Quakers. The group focussed its energy around the social needs that they saw for themselves in Bujumbura, using their musical talent to raise awareness and support..

This funding will enable the project to provide overnight accommodation for the children as well as meeting the costs of their schooling and ensure they have at least one substantial meal a day.
